It is time for the pals to go to bed. Sleep creeps over Shane and Steve and Twain.

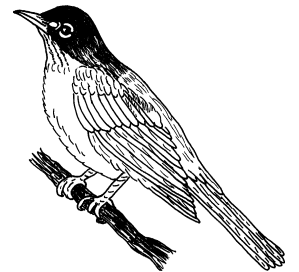
Draw a picture of yourself and of your favorite place to sleep or write a story about it.

The throne is wide. His pal Blaze can sit on the throne with him. Blaze has red braids.

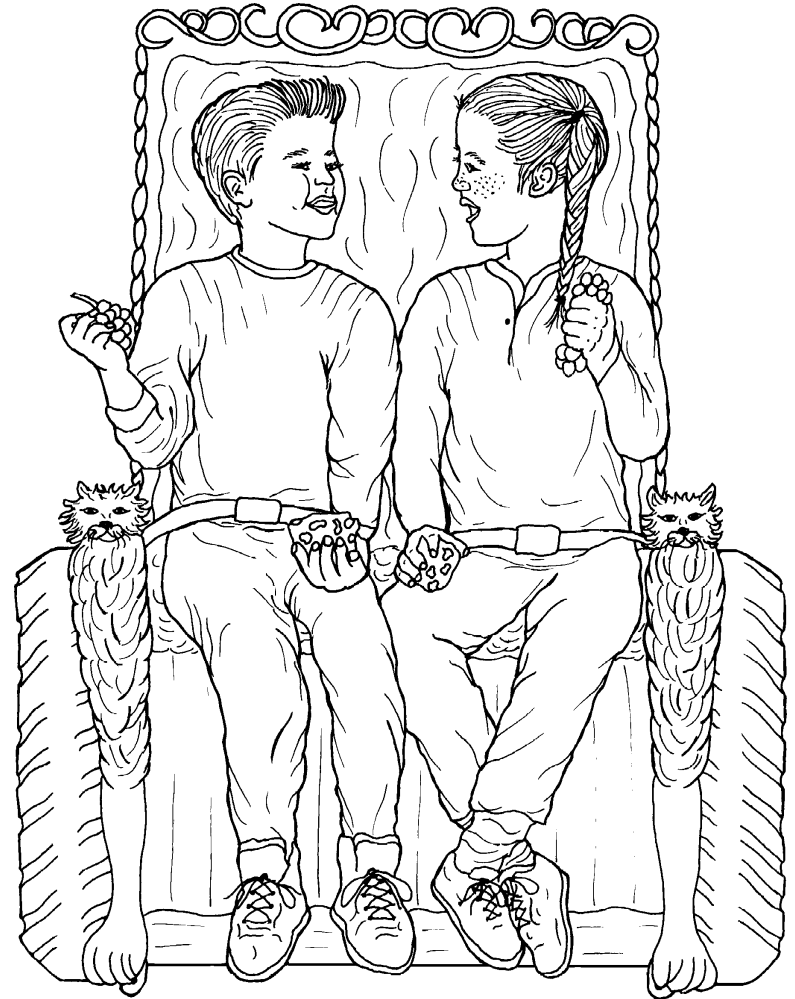


Play

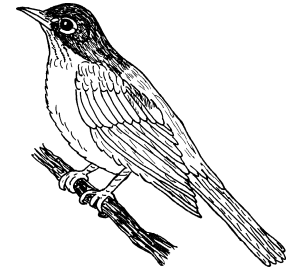

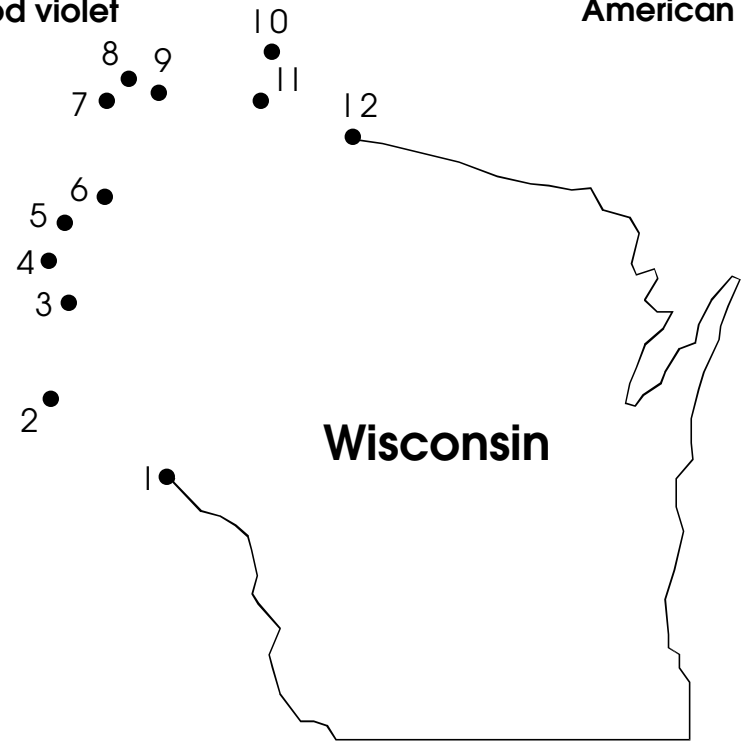

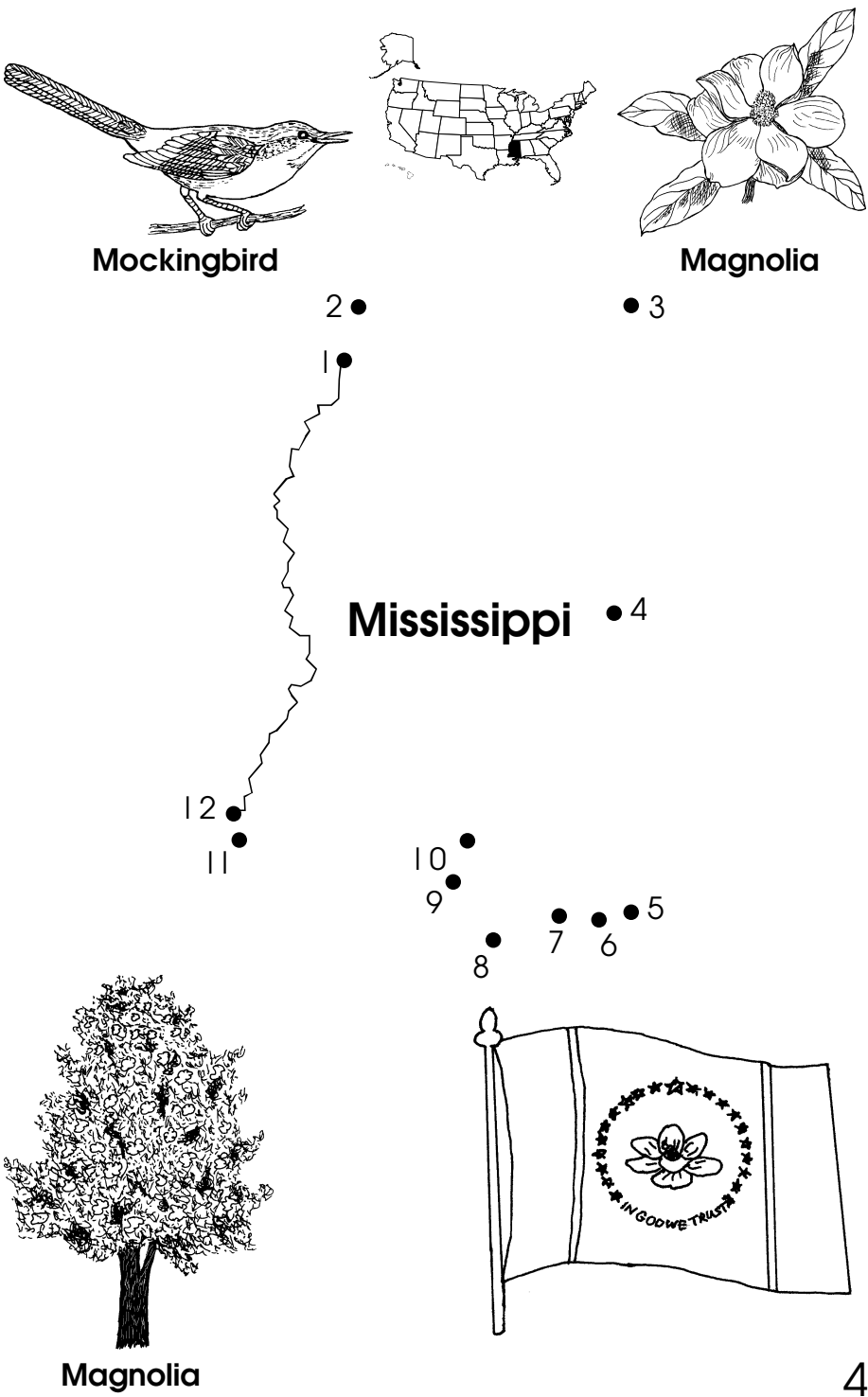

Sunshine wrote a note to her mom.

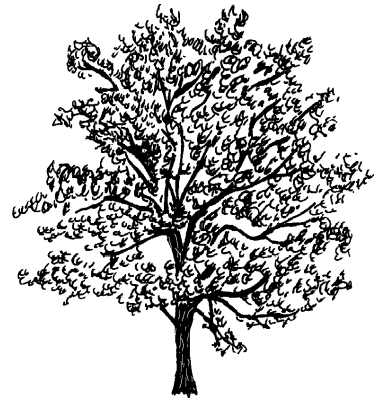

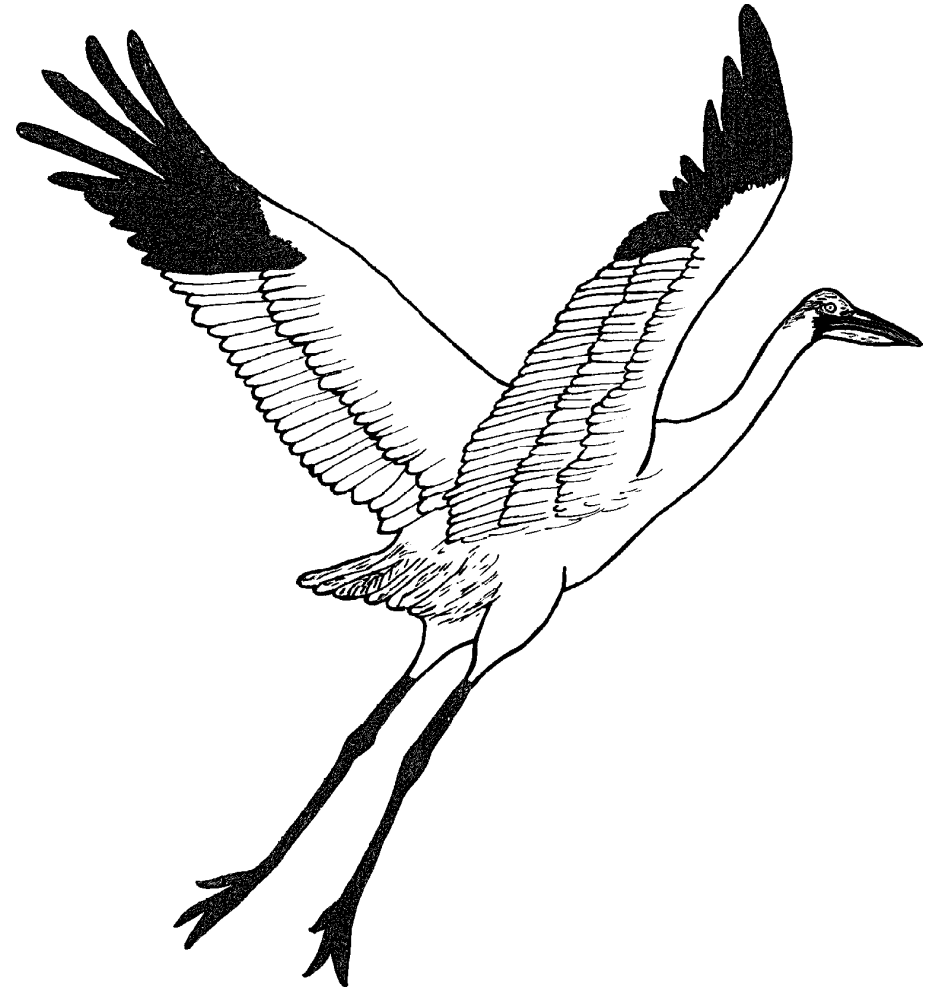


Drake

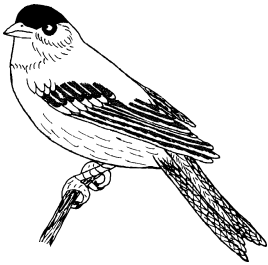
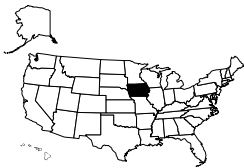

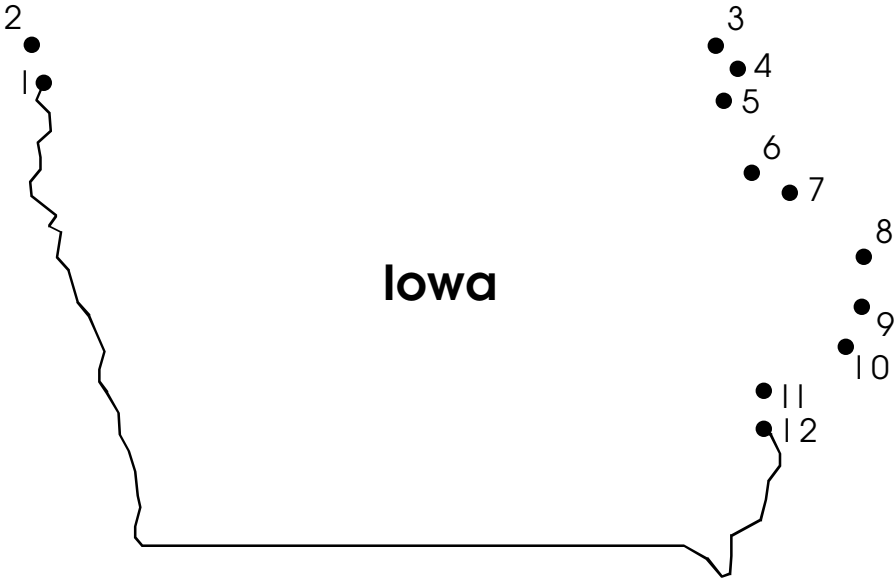
